

CONNECTION PLATE


Dear Customer,

it's our pleasure to inform you that we will deliver a **new connection plate** for the TOORS GUARDY residential door with the standard track system (SL 350 and SL 420) since August 1st, 2014. The new connection plate guarantees a more solid connection between the vertical angle and the bearing plate.

The couple of bearing plates so far used in the residential doors is replaced by a couple of preassembled bearing plates and connection plates for left and right side.



Current solution with single bearing plates (BaaN Code No. T09-040-30-0028 and T09-040-30-0029) requires the complete shaft construction to be entirely fastened onto the lintel. The lintel had to be perfectly solid to be able to carry the whole mass of the shaft and the door leaf. The new T09-005-0049 and T09-005-0050 sets are connected with the vertical angle and the C-profile by screws. Due to this connection the load is split between the vertical angle and the bearing plates fixed to the lintel.



SPECIFICATION

- More stable installation of the shaft
- Both shaft and door leaf mass can be transferred onto the vertical angles
